To students:

- Create daily lesson plans and learning activities for students based on national, local and school standards in science education and research and knowledge of developmental behaviors.
- Deliver high-quality, engaging instruction in the form of discussion, direct teaching, demonstrations and independent practice using a variety of proven methods.
- Differentiate lessons when needed to give all students access to the curriculum regardless of disability, instructional level, English proficiency or level of interest in the subject.
- Plan, implement, and execute engaging and rigorous daily standards---based lessons to ensure that all students master the required content
- Create comprehensive chapter and/or unit tests
- Communicate regularly and proactively with students and families
- Identify students who are academically at risk and initiate effective intervention strategies
- Provide supervision for arrival and dismissal as assigned in order to maintain student safety

To staff:

- Complete other tasks as directed by the Principal as hired
- Report to and be evaluated by the Dean of Academics

To standards:

- Assess students frequently through formal and informal measures
 - Reinforce school-wide rules and expectations
